1.	4 to 6	Hope	A4 drawing sheet	pencils, crayons, pastels or water colors

RULES AND GUIDELINES

PARTICIPATION

- All students **across the UAE** are eligible for participation in the art fiesta.
- The competition is open **to individuals students**.
- Students are expected to participate in the **correct age category** only.

ARTWORK

- All artwork submitted must be an **original idea** and the creation of the student artist only.
- Adults may give encouragement, but **must not** have a hands-on role in creating the artwork.
- Please note that the entries must be in the **correct format** i.e. the size of paper and material used.

SUBMISSION

- Entries of the art work must be sent **latest by Sunday, 7 February 2021** through Google Form. [Submission Link](#)
- Only **one artwork** per participant is allowed.
- A **clear scanned image** (JPG format) of the artwork must be submitted through the link provided below.
- A **short video of 30 to 60 seconds** (Mp4 format) of the participant explaining the artwork must be submitted along with the drawing.
- Please ensure that the **name of the student** is mentioned as the **file name** of the scanned art image.
- Upon receipt of the entries, the **school reserves the right** to use, publish, or otherwise display the work in any relevant platform or event.
- The entries will be assessed on the basis of creativity, imagination, composition, use of colour and choice of subject.

ACCOLADES

- A merit e-certificate for the top 5 artworks in each category.
- A chance to get featured on the social media.
